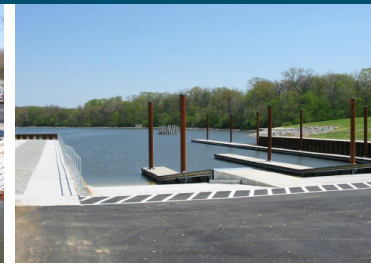


RECREATION PROJECTS



| Program | Due Date | Comments |

| ODNR NatureWorks | June 1 | Recreation/park projects. 75/25 grant to match within county's allocation. PDG Contact: histerm@poggemeyer.com |
| ODNR Land and Water Conservation Fund | November (even years) | These grants provide up to 50 percent reimbursement for outdoor recreation projects. PDG Contact: histerm@poggemeyer.com |
| ODNR Division of Watercraft – Boating Infrastructure Grant (BIG) | July 1 | For transient marina development through USF&W (national competition) for large boats (minimum 26 feet long). Two tier grants: Tier 1 – maximum \$200,000; Tier 2 \$1.5 million. Local 25% match required. PDG Contact: histerm@poggemeyer.com |
| ODNR – Clean Ohio Trails Fund (COTF) and Recreational Trails Program (RTP) | March 2 | Grant programs that provides up to 75% of project cost for COTF and 80% for the RTP. PDG Contact: histerm@poggemeyer.com |
| ODNR- Division of Watercraft- Recreation Harbor Evaluation Program (RHEP) | February 1 | For Lake Erie and Ohio River “non-maintenance” dredging program. Merit based program for public sector watercraft access. Reimbursable grants- no match required. No applications being accepted in 2017. |
| Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) | October 31 | Funding for multi-use paths (non-motorized) that connect destinations. *Priority is given to projects that connection activity centers. LOI is due on October 31. If eligible, ODOT will invite applicant to submit full application by January 31, 2021. Categories to apply under are Bicycle & Pedestrian Facilities*; Community Improvement Activities; Environmental Mitigation Activity; and Recreation Trails (projects offering transportation component will take priority over those only serving a recreational purpose. | Ohio Coastal Management Assistance Grant Program (CMAG) | December | Grants for water related planning projects. 50/50 grant and local match. PDG Contact: histerm@poggemeyer.com |
| Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) | Pre-Applications Due in March-April | Funding for projects in the Appalachian Region in program areas: Community Infrastructure, Education and Training, Health; Transportation and Highways; Distressed Counties Asset-based Development; Tourism Development; Export and Trade Development, Entrepreneurship and Business Development, Energy, and Leadership Development and Capacity Building Eligible applicants include political subdivisions, education, public institutions (port authorities, libraries) and non-profit organizations. Funds are administered by four local development districts. Application process starts in January-February with County Caucus Meetings. PDG Contact: histerm@poggemeyer.com |
